Our annual Park Hill Infant School Talent Show is an ideal opportunity for pupils to demonstrate their talents to their year group, particularly those they may practise outside of school. These talents may take the form of a poetry recital, dance routine, magic show, or may even involve other skills such as gymnastics, football skills, singing, or even joke-telling! The list is endless!

If your child would like the opportunity to participate, please help them choose ONE short performance piece (no longer than one minute in total). If they require music, an instrument, props or a costume, this will need to be organised and provided prior to their audition / performance. Your child can perform as an individual, or can work with friends.

There will be 'Audition days' next week (Monday 10th June – Friday 14th June). All children wanting to audition will need to bring any items required for their audition into school on Monday, in a named plastic bag and kept on their peg, as the auditions will take place throughout the week. If they are choosing to perform with friends, this needs to be organised prior to the audition so that the children are confident performing on the day.

If your child gets selected to perform in the Talent Show during Arts Week, you will receive a message from the school office by Friday 14th June to confirm this and to invite two audience members to attend the show the following week.

If your child has chosen to use a song / music, please ensure they contain age-appropriate lyrics and can be accessed on Spotify, as this is the music platform which will be used on the day. For security reasons, we are unable to accept music links on YouTube, a USB stick or any other portable storage device.
