Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 1 Trip to Brighton

This year, Year One have covered different topics such as 'Pirates' and 'Under the Sea.' To support their understanding of these topics, we have organised trips for all of our Year One children to visit Brighton. Children will be learning about the seaside as part of Geography.

The trip will take place during normal school hours.

Class 5 will be visiting Brighton on **Friday 28th June**

Class 4 will be visiting Brighton on **Tuesday 16th July**

Class 6 will be visiting Brighton on **Wednesday 17th July**

We will be travelling to Brighton via **public transport** so please ensure your child arrives at school promptly at 9.00am to allow us sufficient time to catch our train. The trip will take place during normal school hours – children will return to school by 3.30pm.

Uniform

All children should wear their **full school uniform, comfortable shoes for walking such as trainers** and a **lightweight, weather appropriate jacket or coat** (weather permitting.) Children will need to have a **sun hat** with them. Please apply **sun cream** at home before school.

Please use the Teachers2Parents form to give consent for your child to attend this school trip before Monday 17th June.

Packed Lunches

Children will need to bring their own **packed lunch** including a small bottle of still water in a lightweight backpack so that they are able to participate fully in the day's activities.

If you would like the school to provide a packed lunch for you child, please order one using the Teachers2Parents consent form. **All requests for a packed lunch provided by the school must be received by Monday 17th June** so that the school kitchen can order the appropriate amount of food. Unfortunately, the school kitchen is unable to fulfil any 'on the day' requests for a packed lunch. As with all school meals, there is no charge to parents and carers. Children will still need come to school with a lightweight backpack to carry this lunch in.

Payment

Finally, to contribute towards the cost of the trip, we need to request a donation of **£7.00** for each child. This should be paid on ParentPay or before **Monday 17th June**. Your contribution will be put towards the cost of transport for the trip. Each case will be dealt with confidentially and on an individual basis.
