<p><b>Musical Theatre Club:</b> These sessions will be held in the Hall with Candice Tierney, a qualified, DBS-checked teacher from Betty Wivell Academy. Children will be taught elements of dance and acting to put together their own Musical Theatre performance for parents and carers. The school gate will open for you to collect your child promptly at <b>16:30pm</b> from the main entrance outside the office.</p> <p><b>On Monday 7<sup>th</sup> October, there will be a performance for parents/ carers at 16.15pm</b> – please come to the main school office at this time to be let in. <p><b>Multi-Sports Club:</b> These sessions will be held in the Hall with a qualified, DBS-checked instructor from Totstars Sports Academy. The school gate will open at 16:25pm in order for you to collect your child promptly from <b>16:30pm</b> from the main entrance outside the office.</p>			
Fizzpop Science <b>Thursday's</b>	15:30pm- 16:30pm	Thursday 12 <sup>th</sup> , 19 <sup>th</sup> , 26 <sup>th</sup> September and 3 <sup>rd</sup> & 10 <sup>th</sup> October 2024	£45.00 (five sessions)
<p><b>Fizzpop Science:</b> These sessions will be held in the Starlight Room (opposite Class 1) with a qualified, DBS-checked teacher from Fizz Pop Science. The sessions are designed to inspire children towards gaining an interest in the Sciences, with fun experiments and projects to bring Science to life. The group will be dismissed from the Starlight Room (opposite Class 1 in the huts.) The school gate will open at 16:25pm in order for you to collect your child promptly from <b>16:30pm</b> from the Starlight Room.</p>			

If you would like your child to be considered for an after-school activity in the next half-term on the dates specified above, please complete the online form for the activity you would like your child to attend on Teachers2Parents. **The deadline for all forms to be completed is Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> July at 12pm.**

Once all names have been received, 15 children will be selected to take part in the clubs. Please note: In the interest of fairness, we will be selecting children from a group who have not yet had a chance to take part in an after-school activity club this academic year. In the event that the club is not full, we will then select from children who have previously attended.

**If your child is one of the 15 children selected, you will receive a text advising you of this by Friday 19<sup>th</sup> July 2024.**

Payment via ParentPay will be available after you have received this confirmation. **In order to secure your child's place, you will need to make payment via your child's ParentPay. Deadline for payment will be 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2024.** If payment is not made by then, we will assume that you do not require the place and it will be offered to a child on the waiting list. If you decide that you no longer require the place at a club for your child, please let the school office know as soon as possible so that the place can be offered to another child.

If there is any reason why you are unable to fully meet the cost of this club but you would still like your child to attend, please speak to a member of the Headship team. Each case will be treated confidentially and dealt with on an individual basis.
