Year 2 Medieval Day – Wednesday 22nd January 2025

This half term, Year Two are learning about events from British history, including studying medieval art, architecture, and famous battles and invasions. The children are thoroughly enjoying the topic so far and to consolidate this, we have decided to hold a 'Medieval Day', which will be taking place on Wednesday 22nd January.

We ask that on this day, your child comes to school <u>in costume</u> as a character of their choice from the medieval ages. They may choose to be from a particular group of people (e.g. a Viking), or they may prefer to create their own fictional characters such as a medieval princess, wizard, dragon or knight. We will be holding themed workshops across the Year group on the day. Your child will be able to enjoy a range of activities including archery, artwork, weaving and creating and preparing our very own medieval banquet.

We hope to see as many home-made creations as possible, as we aim for this cross-curricular day to develop the children's creativity, curiosity, and resourcefulness. If you do need any ideas, or if you have any questions about the day, please ask your child's class teacher to discuss this with you.
